General Guidelines

- 1. Effective January, 2006, **no wedding permits** will be issued Memorial Day through Labor Day due to the high volume of visitors and school field trips.
- 2. **Boardwalk Area a Maximum of fifty (50) wedding guests are allowed.** Guests must gather in sand area on the beach seaward of the deck, not on the dunes. Only the wedding party and person(s) officiating ceremony will be allowed on the boardwalk deck due to loading capacity.
- 3. Town Neck / Horizons- Drunken Seal Beach Area Maximum of one hundred and fifty (150) wedding guests allowed. Guests must gather on the beach, not on the dunes.
